AFFIDAVIT

I, KENNETH BLACK of 1435 Water Street, Kelowna, BC, civil servant, AFFIRM THAT:

1. I am a Bylaw Enforcement Officer for the City of Kelowna in this matter. I have personal knowledge of the matters hereinafter deposed to save and except where those matters are stated to be based on information and belief, and to such latter matters I verily believe the same to be true.
2. On October 8, 2022, I attended Stuart Park at 1430 Water Street, Kelowna BC, in the course of my duties as a Bylaw Officer employed by the City to observe the Freedom Rally, which is an event that had been occurring every Saturday for over a year in Stuart Park and surrounding streets, without a permit.
3. As usual, the Freedom Rally was set up by David Lindsay and his supporters in the morning, with sound amplification equipment and signs on and around the plaza stage in Stuart Park below the Bear statue, and two gazebo tents nearby.

4. At around 12:30 p.m., Mr. Lindsay led the attendees of the Freedom Rally on a march through the downtown streets of Kelowna, obstructing pedestrian and vehicle traffic, without a permit from the City to do so.
5. Attached as Exhibit "A" to this Affidavit is a true copy of a photograph I took that day of Mr. Lindsay leading the march of Freedom Rally attendees out of Stuart Park and on to the roadway.

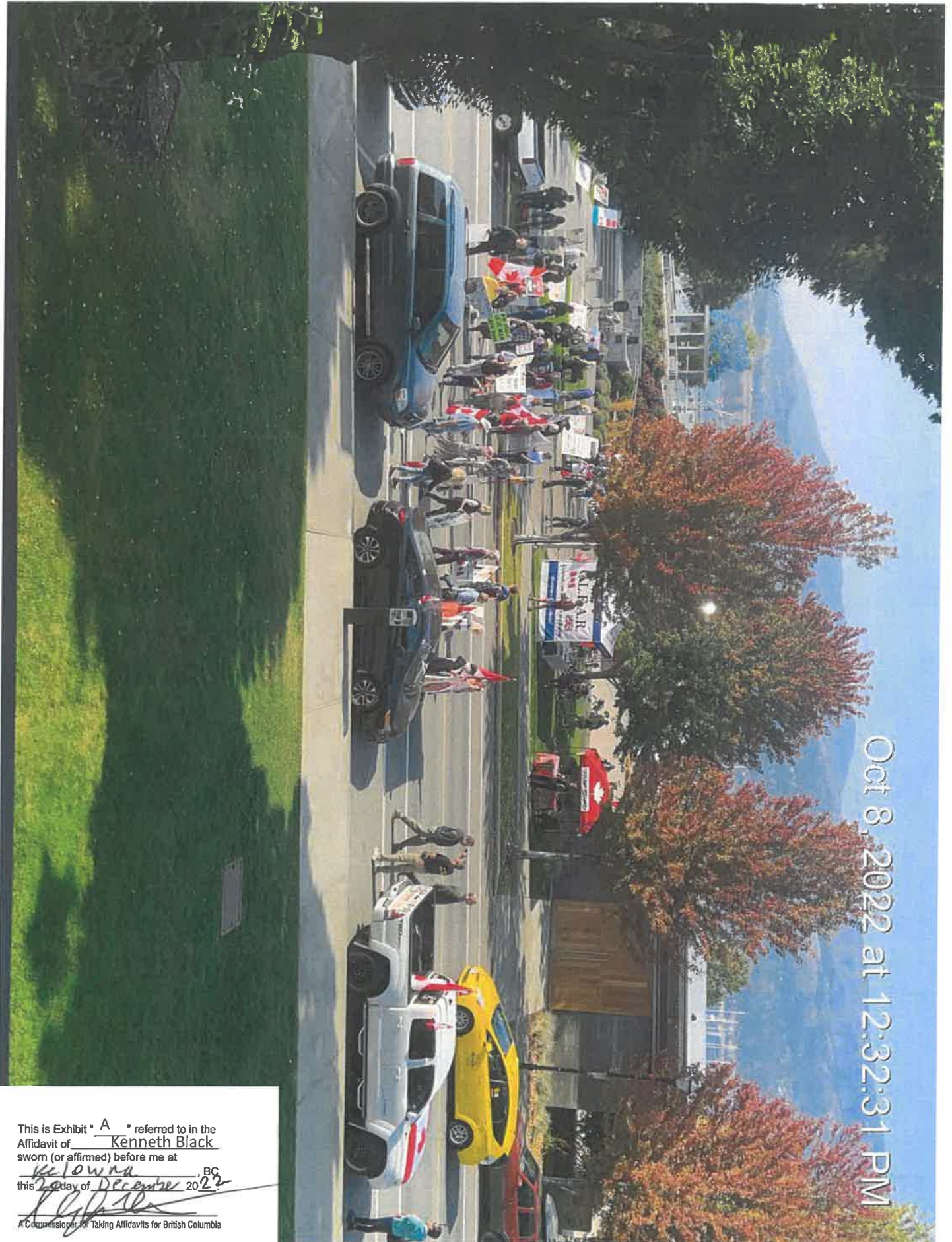
