Affidavit of Bettina Engler Affirmed this 26th day of June, 2023

I, Bettina Engler, of the City of Kelowna, in the Province of British Columbia,

affirm and say that:

1. My name is Bettina Engler. I have regularly attended at the protests against the COVID-19 decisions made by various governments, at Stuart Park in Kelowna.
2. I to Canada about 10 years ago from Europe, where I was raised to think critically against government officials and speak out and to stand up against rights and freedoms deprivations or threats. Prior to the COVID-19 situation, I was not that much politically active however in Canada. COVID-19 changed all that for me.
3. My upbringing supported my decision to oppose all COVID-19 lockdowns, restrictions and mandates. In doing so, I heard of a group also opposing these COVID-19 measures, and began to attend to their protests at Stuart Park.
4. I was the founding member of the World Wide Rally in Canada, which in turn was a part of the German organization, World Wide Demonstration, who were organizing people across the world to protest against all COVID-19 government measures.
5. I reached out to David Lindsay to see if he was interested in joining me and the rest of the world to convey the truth about COVID masking, PCR tests and the false stats about people mass dying based on fear mongering and simply lying. He agreed that I could work with his CLEAR Freedom Rallies that were taking place at Stuart Park. He further represented to me that all their protests were peaceful and he would not accept any violence. I was reassured by

this as I did not want to be involved in violent activities. All protests that I have been to have been peaceful.

6. From the beginning I have heard from many different people, differing names attached to these assemblies, rallies, meetings, walks, marches, demonstrations, and protests. David told me and I do verily believe same to be true, that they were protesting against all COVID-19 lockdowns and restrictions from all levels of government, and the underlying lies in relation to the PCR test that was being used, false statistics, vaccines, and other misrepresentations.
7. The first global protest occurred on March 20th, 2021 and was held in 24 cities across Canada, including Kelowna, plus another 25 in Quebec. A total of 120 cities worldwide in 30 countries expressed their opposition to fake pandemic and false information released by the compromised media.
8. After that David and I have teamed up and we together ran seven World Wide Rallies until March 2022. The WWR became one of the most important and most successful movements in Canada, uniting all provinces and territories in our joint opposition to the COVID-19 lies from all levels of governments, and their Constitutional rights and freedoms restrictions. This enabled me to show solidarity with others around Canada and the world, in our express opposition to all COVID-19 restrictions in our life and the government lies.
9. Tens of thousands of people all over Canada shared our world opposition to all government COVID-19 lies and mandates. What surprised me the most in Canada, is how none of this was reported in main stream media. They would report small little protests on other issues, but report virtually nothing on tens of thousands opposing the government COVID-19 narrative.
10. The Kelowna protests permitted me to express my own reasons for opposing the government COVID-19 narrative, which was critical for my success here in Kelowna. These protests inspired me to start other initiatives, and in the summer of 2022, I founded the Ocean2Ocean Freedom Rally, as a hub for Canadian cities to unite on one day across Canada in our joint opposition to the government COVID-19 narrative and restrictions. Our primary message throughout was that all levels of government were violating people's Constitutional rights and freedoms and without any factual, medical or lawful basis to do so.
11. In the fall of 2022, I founded Geoengineering Free Canada, an organization to combat the spraying of toxins and chemicals into the atmosphere for weather modification, weather warfare and UN Agenda 2023 purposes.
12. I have regularly been speaking at the protests in Kelowna now for over two years. David is was also promoting the WWR and O2O protests, and now on geoengineering issues.
13. These were all made possible due to connections I made and information I was able to convey to people in attendance, while exercising my Constitutional freedom of speech at these protests.
14. I went to these protests every Saturday at Stuart Park to convey the seriousness and permanency of my COVID-19 concerns. The duration varied depending on the number of speakers, and whether we were going to Hwy 97 to protest there.


15. My attendance at these protests was the most effective way I could communicate to the public and the various governments, my beliefs, experiences, information and messages.
16. My primary intentions ins attending these protests were to:
 - a. voice my opposition to government COVID-19 restrictions and mandates such as lockdowns, masks, mandatory vaccination, freedom of choice, freedom of speech, and lack of media visibility to our cause;
 - b. to raise awareness of Gov't overreach;
 - c. to raise awareness of global agendas such as Agenda 2030, Climate change and one world government;
 - d. to unify and raise awareness that individual people are not alone, there were millions of people all over the world who did not believe the government position on COVID-19;
 - e. to hear other people speaking, especially people on the front lines, doctors, nurses, court experts and other professionals, to keep me; updated on the latest information and activities that were happening;
 - f. to hear from victims of the vaccinations who supported my attempts to tell the public and governments that what was happening was wrong.
17. I relied on information freely provided to me at the CLEAR tables and from David when he was speaking, for updates on the COVID-19 situation from our point of view, which was simply not being heard in the main stream media.
18. I utilized the CLEAR literature tables to distribute information and brochures on my Geoengineering activities.
19. These protests enabled me to connect and network with other people.
20. These were not entertainment events or parties and I did not consider them as such. They were all political protests and expressions of our individual and collective opposition to government COVID-19 and other actions that they were taking, that affected me in my private life, such as not being able to shop without a mask, not entering a restaurant without proof of vaccination, not being allowed to see friends and family, and not being able to fly or travel without wearing a mask and proof of vaccination. I used the rallies to express my beliefs to others on these issues.
21. These protests were the only ones in Kelowna and provided me with the unique and valued opportunity to publicly display and convey my opposition to the government on issues such as:
 - I did and do not believe in the stats from the BC, Canadian or any Gov't in the world on COVID-19 deaths and injuries
 - The PCR Test the Govt's were using was manipulated, grossly inaccurate, provided misleading and wrong results

- I opposed the use a mask and the Gov't mandate to wear them. Bonnie Henry was lying that masks stop viruses from spreading
 - I believed that Bonnie Henry, the BC and Federal Gov't were being controlled by international agencies such as the WEF, the WHO and the UN
 - All mandates led to the mandatory "vaccination". I know that the "vaccination" against COVID-19 is highly dangerous, experimental, not against a disease and happened without informed consent, in part because the WHO had to change the definition of what a vaccine was to accommodate these new experimental injections
 - The hospitals were never and nowhere overloaded. After I heard testimonies from international operating doctors and nurses like Dr. Brian Ardis, Dr. Wolfgang Wodarg, Dr. Simone Gold, Dr. Charles Hoffe, Dr. Stephen Malthouse, Prof. Dr. Ulrike Kämmerer, US and Canadian frontline nurses, as well as neighbour nurses working at Kelowna KGH. Hospitals were short staffed due to the Government's mandatory "vaccination" roll out and nurses refused to get jabbed. The Government discriminated against these people
 - I believe in freedom and became a part of this community, connected, mingled and networked with others by showing up every Saturday. I am not going away. I have motivation in part, due to the previous claims by Dr. Bonnie Henry and the B.C. Government that they would be bringing back in these unlawful restrictions again if they had to, and that they are still on the loose, having not been criminally charged for their actions yet. These protests help me express my views that these people should be criminally charged for their actions.
22. I am expecting to speak at these protests again in the future. I strongly believe, from my European background, that I have a message others would benefit from such as historical backgrounds about Communism, The Nuremberg Code and National Socialism our country is facing.
23. In addition to attending to the protests, I was also the leader on several occasions for the street marches that took place in downtown Kelowna with our banners, and to Hwy 97 for our street protests there.
24. I continue to have my same beliefs on issues such as vaccination that I wish to convey my opposition to, and now they have expanded to include:
- 15 min cities
 - Digital ID and currency
 - SOGI programs in our schools 5G
 - Technology
 - Geoengineering and weather modification Chemtrails
 - Changes to our health care system from the BC Government from Bill 36
 - Bill C-11 in relation to the internet
 - Gasoline price fixing
 - Skyrocketing food prices that are not included in the government inflation monitors
 - Vaxx passes being considered by governments


25. During my presence at these protests, not once did I witness or see anyone leaving or prevented from using the Park due to our presence there. None of the dozens of people I met and now know, mentioned anything to me of hearing any similar complaints or issues. I personally did not damage or deface any of the Park property or anywhere else, nor did I witness anyone else doing this.
26. I have seen some homeless people traveling through the Park and sometimes they would gratefully would stop by the CLEAR tables and get free coffee or hot chocolate.
27. I believe the rallies and protests are my right, ethical and conscience duty to express my opposition what I see as being the biggest attack on our rights and freedoms in history, and with no accountability by government officials.
28. As a result of communications to me from other people speaking at these protests, I learned of The Epoch Times, Western Standard, Rebel News, World Doctors Alliance, World Freedom Alliance, and other news outlets other than mainstream media, as well as the work from Dr. Reiner Fuellmich, the recent Corona Investigative Committee (ICIC Law) and the National Citizens Inquiry, where I was able to obtain information that was not being told to the public from our governments and mainstream media.
29. I am greatly concerned that this Petition will shut down our protests at all the best and effective government and media locations. I have been to protest at local media, the RCMP, City Hall, and Interior Health. Being prohibited from protesting outside these locations in my belief, gives them judicial sanctioning of unaccountability. I believe that the only government accountability right now is our ability to publicly protest, especially for the most part with the media refusing to report on our information of criminal activity by our government officials and representatives.
30. Stuart Park is the perfect location for our protests and has been since I started coming to them. I am happy just for the message we are sending being across from City Hall. The ergonomics of the stage area which I have used and help set up equipment upon, are awesome for what we do. I am grateful that while we can still get lots of pedestrian traffic, there is no residential area in the vicinity to worry about. I further worry that any other location is not going to have the same parking space as downtown and we would be encroaching on parking of residents in any such area. I do not believe that we can obtain any better and more effective area than the town square at Stuart Park.
31. I have fully supported David's choice of Stuart Park and it is my choice not to move anywhere else to exercise my common law and s. 2 Charter freedoms. A big investment was made for this location for everyone to know of our protests and our location, it would be a huge problem to have to start from scratch and move somewhere that very few people know of, and that will have a host of other problems from the beginning.
32. I have been at the back of the Park area towards Water St. and I can say that without the speaker system, it would not be possible hear the people speaking nor the messages that they are trying to convey to me. I have heard the speakers when they are turned down low and people have been complaining to raise the volume because they are denied their ability to hear that far back. This is compounded by people who talk around me, and the traffic from the street, including trucks and diesels.

- 33. As a person speaking, I do not have the ability to yell or talk loud enough for the length of an average 10-15 minute presentation, for large numbers of people to hear me, and doing so would likely hurt my vocal cords after any length of time. I would not be able to convey my messages to the crowd and they would not be able to hear me. I would either have to seriously limit my freedom of expression, or not exercise it at all.
- 34. I make this Affidavit true and correct, in support of the Respondents' response and opposition to the Petition, and for no improper purpose.
